Our clinic sees patients of all genders with congenital anomalies, commonly called birth defects, which are anatomic variations present at birth that can cause health problems or affect how the body works.

The Northwestern Medicine Transitional Adult Congenital Genitourinary (TRAC) Clinic provides comprehensive and continuous care for patients with any congenital conditions of the genitourinary system. These conditions can affect the reproductive and urinary systems of patients of any gender, and require long-term, expert urologic and multispecialty care from childhood into adulthood.

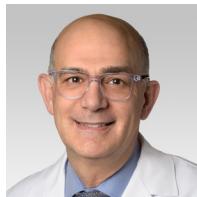
